Dear Fellow Conrail Employees:

As we all continue to do our part in the fight against the spread of COVID-19, we would like to thank you for adhering to the health and safety guidelines issued by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the World Health Organization (WHO). Practicing social distancing, wearing face masks when in public and frequent hand washing along with cleaning and sanitizing high touch surfaces is slowing the spread of the virus.

We also want to reassure you that the health and safety of Conrail employees is our top concern, and we remain diligent in our efforts to protect you.
